The community of Walcha has had their water supply and water reserves boosted thanks to the completion of an \$11 million drought - security project.

The project was completed with the delivery of a 300 megalitre (ML) off - stream water storage dam, pump station and pipelines.

The project was funded thanks to \$2 million from the Albanese Labor Government, through its National Water Grid Fund, and a further \$9 million from the NSW Government.

Increasing the water storage will enable the Walcha community to be in a stronger position to weather a drier climate and provide a safer and more secure pipeline of water.
