There were 39 candidates contesting the election.

Mr Taber and Mr Widders did not meet the selection threshold but were able to secure a seat after leading the vote count once preferences were exhausted.

Tickets will be \$150 each excluding charges

Identification (a driver’s licence/similar) with an address demonstrating residence in eligible postcode must be presented to purchase tickets

According to Ms Davis, thousands of visitors are expected to be in Armidale for this event.
